

MEDICAID CHANGES ARE COMING

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

As many as 5.3 million children may lose their Medicaid coverage during this redetermination process; 3.8 million of these losses are expected to be due to “procedural” reasons (i.e., enrollees cannot be reached or did not return re-enrollment forms). Don't let yourself fall into this trap.



ABOUT MEDICAID

Medicaid is a lifeline program, and right now children and families are at risk of losing their coverage as states review their programs and check who is still eligible.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO MAINTAIN COVERAGE

As information is sent out from the Louisiana Medicaid Program, it is important that families enrolled in our state Medicaid program, follow these important steps to help protect your coverage.



Update your address with the Louisiana Medicaid Program



Check your mail for official notices from the Louisiana Medicaid Program.



Complete and return any forms mailed to you as quickly as possible. Even if the deadline has passed, still return your forms

If you find out you've lost your Medicaid coverage, you may be able to regain it if you return your renewal form and all needed material within a 90-days. If you or your child are truly no longer eligible for Medicaid, you may be eligible for other low-cost coverage, such as through LaCHIP or the Marketplace.
